Section 3 Resident and Business Status Certification

In accordance with federal regulations, the City of Franklin is seeking businesses and residents of Venango County interested in becoming certified as a Section 3 Business or Resident. If certified, a Section 3 Business will be placed on a list and will be automatically notified of all contracting, subcontracting and supplier opportunities on HUD-funded projects over \$100,000 in the City of Franklin. A Section 3 resident, if qualified, will be notified of all training and employment opportunities made available by a Section 3 covered project in Franklin.

A Section 3 Business is defined as: one in which a Section 3 Resident owns 51% or more of the business; OR in which at least 30% of the full-time employees are Section 3 Residents; OR that has committed 25% of subcontracted dollar amounts to Section 3 Businesses. A Section 3 Resident is a resident of Venango County who qualifies as low- or very-low-income and/or receives public housing assistance.

Any businesses or individuals interested in being certified for Section 3 eligibility can request certification forms by contacting the Community Development Department at Franklin City hall, 430 – 13th St., Franklin, PA 16323, Ph. 437-7841.
